

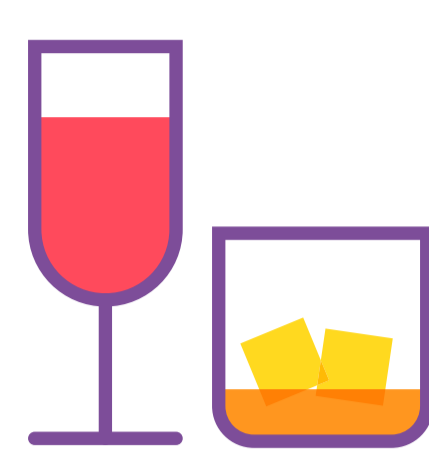

1912

London's first gay club opened



1907

Gertrude Stein met Alice B. Toklas and started a relationship and even opened a 'salon'

1920s

The rise of drag culture and drag balls



1936

British Athletic champion Mark Weston transitioned from female to male

1950

Harry Hay co-founds the Mattachine Society first LGBT rights group in the USA



1948

Harry Hay has the idea for a LGBTQ+ activist group

1957

The Wolfenden report was published

1967

The Sexual Offences Act came in

1970s

Gay News first newspaper on queer issues founded in the UK



1969

The Stonewall Riots

1984

Chris Smith, Labour chairman of the Environment Agency, comes out as gay

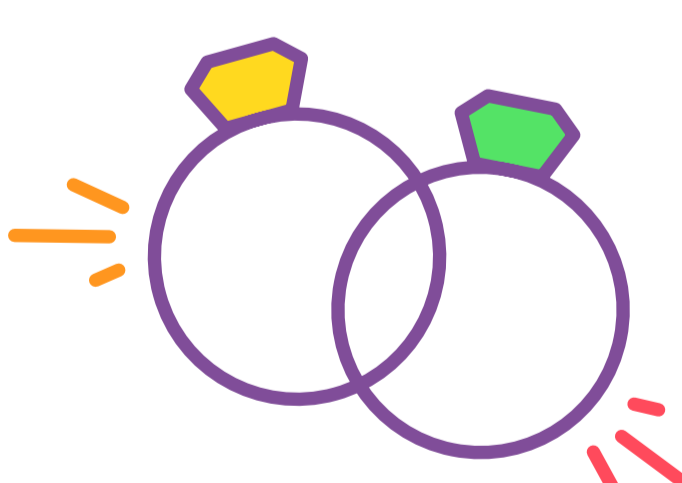
1992

2004

The Civil Partnership Act 2004, which gave same-sex couples the same rights as married heterosexual couples



2002

Same-sex couples applying for adoption were granted equal rights

2019

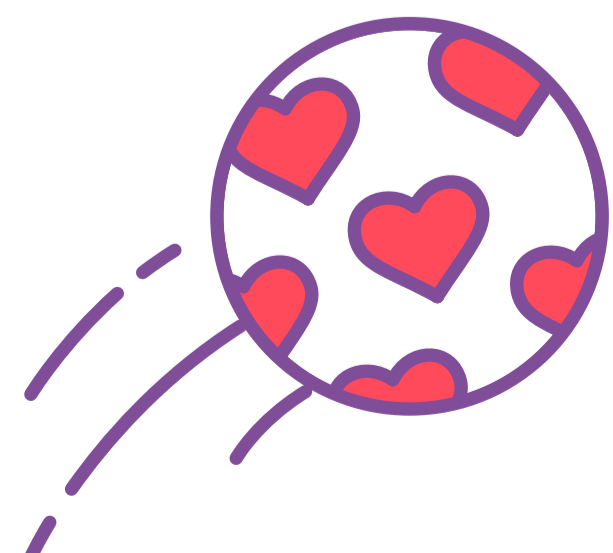
LGBTQ+ content became established in school curriculums across England
